Dear Parents / Carers,

We are pleased to inform you that our school has been invited to take part in the Harrogate Primary SEND Panathlon Festival being held at St Aidan's High School on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2025 between 9.30am – 1.00pm. This event is being run by Harrogate School Games and the Panathlon Foundation. All children taking part in this event are on the SEND register for various additional needs and it is an opportunity for the children to experience a positive sporting event. There will be a range of activities including Bocca, table cricket, new age kurling and messi football, plus much more.

If you would like your child to take part in this event, please apply for your child's place on the Arbor app (Trips). The portal for this event will open on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> February 2025 at 6pm and close again on the morning of Friday 7<sup>th</sup> February at 9am. If the app does not allow you to book a place, it means all the spaces are full (only 8 spaces available).

You will need to collect your child from school in good time to arrive at the venue and be ready to take part. If another adult will be taking your child, please contact the office to let them know. The children need to be at St. Aidan's for 10am, so we suggest a pick-up time of 9.30am. On arrival, please register your child with a member of staff from Saltergate School. A Saltergate jersey will be given to your child to wear for the event (this will need to be returned before you leave).

Please note that you will be responsible for any children you have taken and they should remain in your care until called for their event by a Saltergate staff member. Once the event starts, the children will be in the care of a Saltergate member of staff as they take part in the competition. Your child and any other children you are responsible for will be returned to their adults at the end of the event and returned to school for the afternoon lessons. Unfortunately, this is a closed event, so no spectators are allowed into the venue once the event starts. Your child will need a pack lunch to eat on their return to school.

Please can we ask to ensure your child's place on this event, you must apply for your child's place on the Arbor app by Friday 7<sup>th</sup> February, as there are a limited number of spaces available and spaces will be given on a first come, first serve basis.
