### **Infants – Pyjamas/Comfy Clothes Day**

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope this letter finds you well. I wanted to share with you the outcome of a recent school council meeting where the infant students expressed a desire to be more independent during the lunch serving process. The students have requested to have lunch trays so they can go up to the counter and choose and collect their food themselves.

In order to make this possible, the students have come up with a creative solution to contribute to the cost of the trays. They have proposed holding an Infant School Non-Uniform Day on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> June, where students will be allowed to wear their favourite pyjamas or comfy clothes to school. Children will be asked to donate £1 or whatever you can afford through the Voluntary Contributions payment item on ParentPay. The money raised from this non-uniform day will go towards purchasing the trays for the students to use during lunchtime.

We believe that encouraging independence and responsibility among our children is an important part of their development. By providing them with the tools they need to take control of their own lunch serving process, we are empowering them to make choices and develop valuable life skills.

We appreciate the initiative and enthusiasm shown by the students in finding a solution to support their request. We hope that you will support this fundraising effort by allowing your child to participate in the non-uniform day and contribute to the cause.
