Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to inform you that on Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> March Year 3 will be going on a visit to the **RHS Gardens at Harlow Carr, Harrogate** as an integral part of our science work all about plants.

We will be leaving school at **9:15am** prompt, so please ensure your child arrives at school no later than **8:45am**. We will spend the morning attending an expert-led workshop all about pollination and how plants grow. Then we will have our packed lunches before exploring the gardens and wide variety of plants together. We will return to school in plenty of time for normal collection at 3.15pm.

Please note that all children must wear **appropriate footwear** and must bring a **waterproof coat**. Each child **must wear their school jumpers** but are allowed to wear **comfortable trousers** (e.g. tracksuit bottoms). They will also need to bring a **packed lunch and water bottle, all of which should be carried in a rucksack**.

We are asking for a contribution of **£5.50** per child to cover transport costs. Entry to the garden and the workshop is free of charge. Unfortunately schools do not have a budget to pay for trips so if we are unable to cover the cost of the transport, this trip will have to be cancelled and will not go ahead. Please therefore make payment by no later than Friday 14<sup>th</sup> February 2025.

If your child qualifies for Free School Meals, a packed lunch can be provided from school. Complete the form using the link on this letter by Friday 14<sup>th</sup> March 2025.
