Young Voices

Please note, the children are already allocated to Young Voices until the end of Spring 1 and the Young Voices event, so they cannot apply for a new club until the Summer term. However, in Spring 2 (after the concert) your child will still be able to attend a club as part of the same group (Young Voices children) with a new member of staff and they will get the opportunity to do different activities every week for that term (five weeks), these could include activities such as dodgeball, arts and crafts, music and board games.

If your child decides they do not want to carry on with the club in Spring 2, please can you contact the office to let us know and we can remove your child from the register, your child will not however be able to join any of the other clubs on offer.

Razzmatazz

All the children who sign up for our 'Razzmatazz VE Performance Club' must commit to this club for Spring 1 and Spring 2, so we are fully prepared for the amazing VE concert at Harrogate's Convention Centre. There will be some costs which are linked to this club/event and these will need to be payable by parents. Firstly, there will be the cost of transporting your child to Harrogate Convention Centre via coach, we will be in touch with the cost of the coach in the near future once we know how many children we will be transporting to the event.

Moreover, parents who would like to attend the concert will need to purchase a ticket. The ticket prices for this event have been subsidised and will be between £10-£15. Tickets will be available online in a couple of weeks. You do not need to pay for a ticket for your child. Before deciding whether to join this club, you and your child must be aware that they will need to attend a very lengthy but enjoyable rehearsal during the afternoon of 3rd April. All our Razzmatazz children will then remain at the Convention Centre with school staff until the end of the concert, making it a long day. However, it will be an unforgettable and unique experience for them! The concert will start at 7:15pm and will be finished by 9:30pm.
